PURPOSE: The purpose of this position is to ensure that the Delaware Solid Waste Authority completes all necessary environmental monitoring and testing required by the permits that allow for the operation of the municipal solid waste in the state of Delaware.

JOB DUTIES

ESSENTIAL TASKS:

Essential functions are fundamental, core functions common to all positions in the class series and are not intended to be an exhaustive list of all job duties for any one position in the class. Since class specifications are descriptive and not restrictive, incumbents can complete job duties of similar kind not specifically listed here.

- Manages the collection of environmental data. Analyzes collected data and compiles reports including data assessments.
- Conducts field investigations related to soil, ground water, surface water, leachate and landfill gas.
- Prepares, summarizes and reports on field investigations.
- Prepares monthly technical reports
- Prepares permit required written submissions.
- Performs field work related to environmental data.
- Responsible for the selection, procurement, installation, and maintenance of all environmental monitoring equipment.
- May responds to emergency calls.

ADDITIONAL DUTIES:

- Purchases safety equipment for field work as needed.
- Assists with oversight of construction
- Assists with semi-annual and annual reports.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, AND SKILLS:

Requires 5 years of experience as a DSWA Environmental Scientist..

Must possess a valid driver's license and CPR and First Aid certification (Certification training provided by DSWA) , smoke school certification,

Knowledge of principles and practices of the environmental sciences. Knowledge of controlled sampling techniques. Knowledge of the methods, techniques and procedures of data collection and compilation. Knowledge of the concepts of mathematics, chemistry, biology and physical science. Ability to conduct field studies, tests, surveys and investigations based on environmental science principles and practices. Ability to research and interpret regulations. Ability to work with electronic data processing methods. Ability to compile, analyze and interpret statistical data. Ability to apply federal and state environmental laws, rules and regulations. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing.

Note: This is a safety sensitive position and requires drug testing as a condition of employment.

Physical Requirements:

This position requires standing, walking, sitting, reaching with hands and arms, stooping, kneeling, crouching, or crawling, talking or hearing.

This position requires no lifting.

No special vision requirements.
