JOB CLASS: NON-EXEMPT

PURPOSE:

To provide support services related to engineering or environmental data acquisition and systems maintenance.

JOB DUTIES:

- * Monitors and maintains environmental protection and monitoring systems including but not limited to landfill gas, leachate collection, leachate recirculation, groundwater monitoring, surface water monitoring and air monitoring systems as required
- * Inspects operations of environmental protection and monitoring systems to evaluate system performance and identify potential malfunctions
- * Respond to on-call alarms (24-hour) to identify and rectify the source of the environmental protection and monitoring system alarms.

Perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Possession of a high school diploma and any relevant experience with the above duties. Possession of a valid driver's license. Must be able to work in adverse weather conditions. Must possess basic knowledge of mechanics and heavy equipment.
